

# A Legacy of Healing

AMITA Health welcomed Presence Health to the organization in March 2018, making AMITA Health the largest health system in Illinois. With double the doctors at triple the locations, our care now extends throughout the entire Chicago area and surrounding suburbs.

#### **Alexian Brothers Health System**

Alexian Brothers Health System is a comprehensive, diversified Catholic health system consisting of five hospitals and outpatient facilities. It is part of St. Louis-based Ascension, the nation's largest non-profit health system and the world's largest Catholic health system. Ascension is comprised of healthcare facilities in 21 states and the District of Columbia.

In 1866, Brother Bonaventure Thelen established the first Alexian Brothers Hospital for men and boys in a small house on Dearborn Street in Chicago. Today, the Alexian Brothers carry out the healing mission of the Catholic Church by identifying and developing effective responses to the health and housing needs of those they are called to serve.



#### **Adventist Midwest Health**

Adventist Midwest Health – comprised of four acute-care hospitals and outpatient facilities – is part of AdventHealth, based in Altamonte Springs, FL. Adventist Health System has 45 hospital campuses in 10 states and serves more than 4.5 million patients annually.

As a mission-driven organization, and part of the Seventh-day Adventist Church, Adventist Midwest Health has provided a legacy of healing and compassion to the communities it serves by remaining united in the mission of extending Jesus' healing ministry.




#### Presence Health

Presence Health is a comprehensive system of 10 hospitals and more than 150 locations throughout Illinois. The system was founded in 2011 when two long-established Catholic health systems – Provena Health and Resurrection Health Care – came together to form one of the largest integrated health systems in Illinois. In 2018, Presence Health joined with Ascension and became part of AMITA Health.
